CONFESSION OF FAITH: RESPONSIVE READING

Leader: What is it that God requires of us, so that we may escape his wrath and curse due to us because of our transgression of the law?

People: In order to escape the wrath and curse of god, he requires us to repent, and exhibit faith toward our Lord Jesus Christ, and to be diligent in the use of the outward means that Christ uses to communicate to us the benefits of his mediation.

Leader: What are the outward means that Christ uses to communicate to us the benefits of his mediation?

People: The outward and ordinary means are all his ordinances; especially the word, sacraments, and prayer; all of which are made effectual to the elect for their salvation.

Leader: What is a sacrament?

People: a sacrament is a holy ordinance instituted by Christ for his church, to signify, seal and exhibit to those who are in the covenant of grace the benefits of his mediation, to strengthen and increase their faith and all other graces, to call them to obedience; to proclaim and deepen their love and communion one with another; and mark them as being separate from the world.

CONFESSION OF SIN—IN UNISON

O merciful Heavenly Father, we come to You confessing our sins, for we are a people who often stray from your grace and the light of your righteousness. We confess, that in many ways, we have ignored your Word and its commands, its authority over our lives and actions, and so in our rebellion, we have sinned in your sight.
